



SEPTEMBER 19TH, 2018 – Tomorrow's Voices Training Institute Workshop, "Lending A Helping Hand: A Workshop on How to Assist Using Prompting" - Attendees of this workshop learned about the different ways to prompt and how to identify the appropriate prompting method for the individual your working with. The workshop had 18 attendees, which included parents, teachers and health professionals.

SEPTEMBER 2018 – Tomorrow's Voices Host Nursing Students from Bermuda College – For a one month period four nursing students from the Bermuda College came in to shadow our staff as a part of their placement program. This partnership with the Bermuda College allowed nursing students to come into the Centre to observed therapy, shadow therapists, and learn the techniques used to work with clients on the autism spectrum.

OCTOBER 20TH, 2018 – Tomorrow's Voices Team On HOTT 1075 Radio Show – Senior Therapist, Jahnae Harvey and Co-Founder & Board Chair, Thea Furbert were invited on HOTT 1075 radio show to talk about Autism and Tomorrow's Voices. During the interview with host "Qian Dickinson" the team was able to discuss the symptoms of autism, ABA therapy and how Tomorrow's Voices supported the community.

OCTOBER 22ND, 2018 – Tomorrow's Voices 11th Anniversary – We hit another milestone and celebrated 11 years of providing services to Bermuda's children, parents, educators, allied health professionals and the community. With over 69,786 hours of therapy provided to children in the community, Tomorrow's Voices continues to support those children, families and friends struggling with Autism Spectrum Disorders and Developmental Disabilities.

NOVEMBER 21ST, 2018 – Tomorrow's Voices Training Institute Workshop, "Catching Behavior On The Flip Side"
- This workshop outlined and explained strategies that could be used before an unwanted behavior happens, using antecedent strategies as a form of managing behavior. The workshop was attended by 23 participants which included parents, teachers and health professionals.

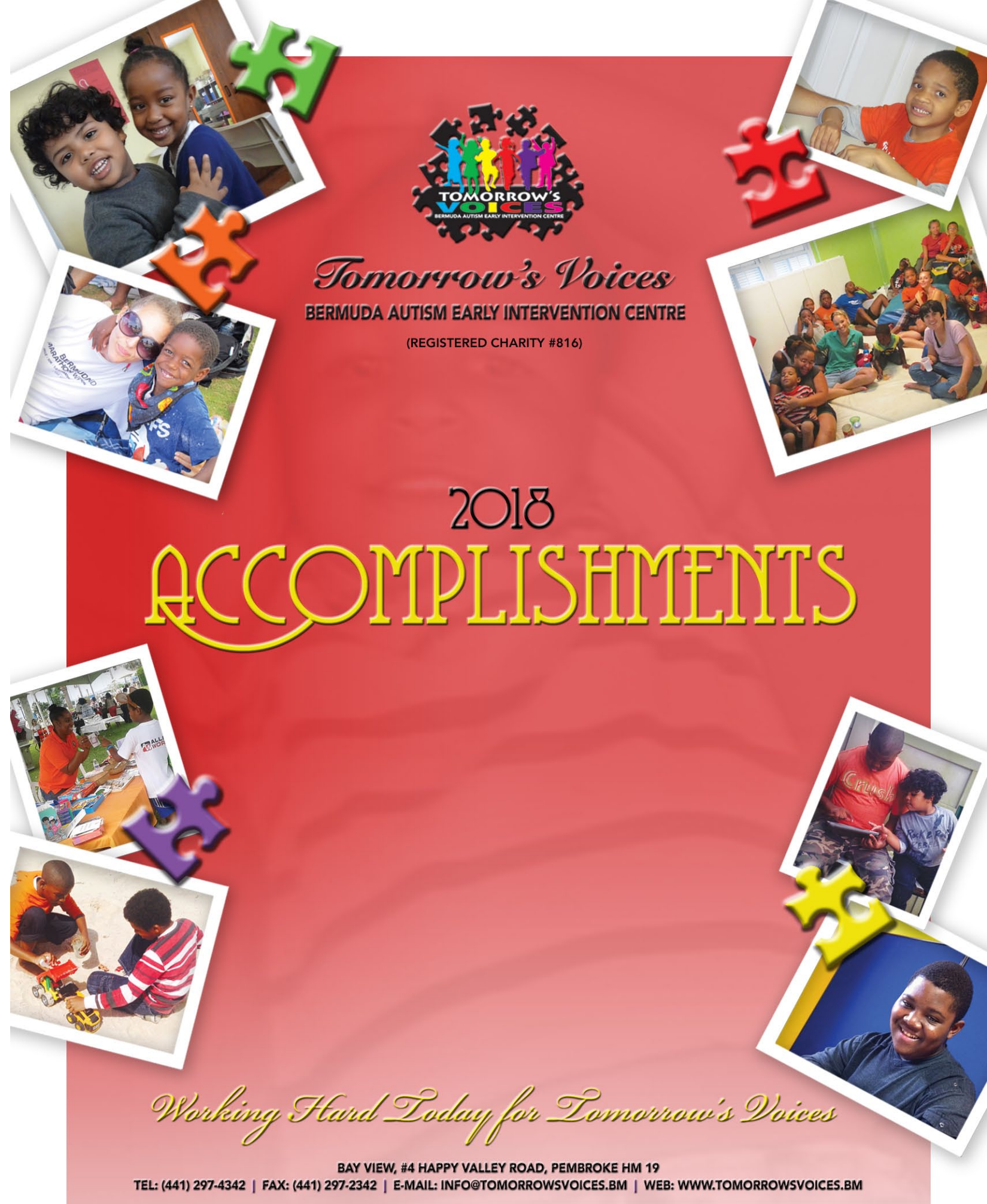

Working Hard Today for Tomorrow's Voices

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JAN 13&27; FEB 10&24; MAR 10&24; APRIL 28; MAY 12; JUNE 9&23; SEPT 8&22; OCT 13&27, NOV 24; DEC 8, 2018 – Saturday Social Skills - We held 16 Social Skills groups on the 2nd and 4th Saturday of each month during 2018. The Social Skills group which runs from 9am to 1pm on Saturdays has hosted a number of children with autism and other developmental disabilities as well as students without disabilities. The Social Skills group provides those with developmental disabilities the opportunity to work on social skills, functional skills and language skills while participating in outings within the community. This group also provided parents with respite time to facilitate things they may have had to do, while knowing that their children were being supervised by skilled staff and volunteers.

FEBRUARY 21ST, 2018 – Tomorrow’s Voices Hosts its First Training Institute Workshop of 2018 entitled **“Show Me What You Know - Assessment & Programming for Individuals with Autism”**. This workshop presented by our Senior Therapists provided attendees with information on symptoms that may impact the assessment process and various assessment tools. This workshop hosted parents, teachers and allied health professionals.

MARCH 2018 – Tomorrow’s Voices Voted “Best Early Autism Intervention Program - Caribbean” –Tomorrow’s Voices won a Global Health and Pharma 2018 Social Care Award for Best Early Autism Intervention Program - Caribbean. We were featured in the GHP 2018 Social Care Awards Magazine which was circulated worldwide to 260,000 subscribers interested in need-to-know news and the newest developments affecting the global healthcare and pharmaceutical industries. The team was very proud for winning this award and being honoured by the international arena.



MARCH 1ST, 2018 – Tomorrow’s Voices Meets with Insurance Company to Advocate for ABA Insurance Coverage - Tomorrow’s Voices team met with a local insurance company to open the dialogue on the coverage of ABA services. The meeting was beneficial in providing the insurance company with dialogue on what ABA is, what are the recommendations of services for clients with developmental disabilities and why it was important for them to cover this medically recommended treatment. Later in 2018 we were advised by the Insurance Company that they would start the coverage of Behavioral services. This was fantastic to hear as this would help parents with the cost for the much needed therapy.



MARCH 29TH, 2018 – Tomorrow’s Voices Special Featured in “Royal Gazette Supplement”. As a part of Autism Awareness Month Tomorrow’s Voices had a Special Feature in the Royal Gazette Newspaper. The four page spread featured interviews from Tomorrow’s Voices staff, Parent Interviews, Senior Therapists Jahnae Harvey’s research Poster as well as highlighted some of our community partners and accomplishments in the field of autism and developmental disabilities. The four page spread featured ads from some of our corporate partners and donors and acknowledged how Tomorrow’s Voices’ services are making a much needed difference in the Bermuda community.



APRIL 2ND, 2018 – Tomorrow’s Voices “Light It Up Blue” For Autism. During the month of April Tomorrow’s Voices participated in the “Light It Up Blue” International Autism Awareness promotion by hanging blue lights on the Centre windows and the Tree in the front yard. Community members that passed the Centre in the evening were able to see the Blue lights shining as we joined the rest of the world in celebrating autism awareness.

APRIL 1ST TO MAY 4TH, 2018 – Tomorrow’s Voices Autism Awareness Month Activities – Tomorrow’s Voices hosted 4 events during Autism Awareness Month to highlight our services and to raise funds for our Centre. Events included “Bounce For Autism” on April 14th, “Autism Rocks Socks” on April 27th, “Saturday Social Skills Gives Back to the Community” on April 28th, and “Autism Tags It” on May 4th.

APRIL 11TH & 12TH, 2018 – Radio Interviews To Promote Autism Awareness Month - Cofounder and Board Chair, Thea Furbert and Senior Therapist, Jahnae Harvey were interviewed by radio host at HOTT 1075, The Ladies Room and VIBE103. Radio listeners were able to find out about the services of Tomorrow’s Voices, facts about Autism, as well as all of the wonderful events Tomorrow’s Voices were hosting during the month of April to celebrate Autism Awareness Month.



APRIL 14TH, 2018 – Tomorrow’s Voices 7th Annual “Bounce For Autism” Fun Day – We hosted our 7th Annual community fun day at the Police Field. Over 600 children and their parents attended the event which featured performances by the Bermuda Jump Rope Federation, DanceSations School of Dance, Live Wires and other local entertainment. Attendees enjoyed a record number of 15 bouncy castles and bouncy activities. The day turned out to be entertaining for the entire family and especially those children touched by Autism.



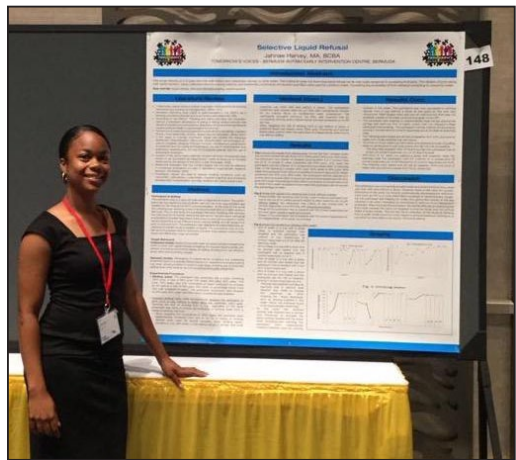
APRIL 27TH, 2018 – “Autism Rocks Socks” Charity Fundraiser - Tomorrow’s Voices hosted our Annual Autism Rocks Socks fundraiser. Participants were encouraged to have fun while showing support for our Charity. Companies and Schools were invited to participate in our unique fundraiser by wearing crazy, fun socks on this day and donating \$5 to Tomorrow’s Voices. Around 25 companies and schools participated to raise funds for our Centre.



APRIL 28TH, 2018 – Tomorrow’s Voices Saturday Social Skills Group Gives Back During Autism Awareness Month - Tomorrow’s Voices facilitated this special Social Skills Group by giving back to the community. Staff, clients and volunteers visited local parks and participated in a clean up of the grounds to show their appreciation to the community.

MAY 4TH, 2018 – “Autism Tags It” Tomorrow’s Voices Tag Day - Tomorrow’s Voices hosted our 5th Annual Tag Day with volunteers stationed throughout the City of Hamilton distributing Autism Ribbons and Tags for small donations to the Charity. The day saw hundreds of people in the community donating to this worthy cause.

MAY 17TH, 2018 – Tomorrow’s Voices VB Therapists Provide Free Workshop to Community. As a part of their Professional Development two of Tomorrow’s Voices VB Therapists presented a workshop to community educators. The Workshop entitled “All About Reinforcement” assisted attendees in defining, assessing and using reinforcement to increase or decrease the likelihood of a behavior repeating itself in the future. The workshop was provided free to all attendees.



MAY 26-30, 2018 – Tomorrow’s Voices Staff Member Presents Bermuda Research Papers at ABAI Conference in San Diego – Sr. Therapist, Jahnae Harvey, traveled to San Diego to present her Research Poster on “Selective Liquid Refusal” at the 44th Annual Applied Behavior Analysis International Conference (ABAI). Jahnae was the first ever Bermudian to present research at ABAI, with her poster featuring research compiled from client data at Tomorrow’s Voices. As there is very little research on “Selective Liquid Refusal” Jahnae received a great deal of interest in her poster at the conference and she was also encouraged to publish her findings.

JUNE 20TH, 2018 – Tomorrow’s Voices Training Institute workshop. This workshop entitled **“All About Reinforcement”** provided attendees with training information on defining, assessing and using reinforcement to increase or decrease the likelihood of a behavior repeating itself in the future. This workshop, presented by our two VB Therapists, had 20 attendees which represented parents, educators, health professionals and others in the community.

JULY 4TH - AUGUST 28TH, 2018 – Tomorrow’s Voices Summer Camp Programme - Tomorrow’s Voices hosted our Summer Camp program for the tenth consecutive year. The Summer Camp program served 17 children with various abilities ranging from Autism to other Developmental Disabilities. Students aged 2 to 21 years participated in weekly outings, water play, cooking, language games, outdoor sports and many other activities that challenged them to have a happy and healthy summer.

SEPTEMBER 12TH, 2018 – Tomorrow’s Voices Host Parent Support & Information Session - Parents were provided information on the resources available at Tomorrow’s Voices as well as tools to support their children as they navigate new environments and schools. Three parents were also invited to share their stories with new parents. Parents were able to bring their children along and TV had staff and volunteer on hand to make sure the children were engaged and taken care of so that parents could fully engage in the training and information session. 13 parents were able to attend the session.
